QA Tech Lev 2 will perform receiving inspections, welding inspections, audit in process inspections, and finished product inspections to ensure products and processes conform to written Tandemloc Inc quality procedures and policies. This position will inspect and witness load tests of products as well as assist QA administrative assistant with calibration and assist Proof Testing Department with maintaining load test equipment. Assisting other areas including Shipping Department and Production, as needed. Working safely to prevent on-the-job injuries by following all Tandemloc, State, and Federal guidelines is required to include the use of proper approved personal protective equipment including but not limited to safety glasses, safety toed shoes, gloves, hearing protection, face shields as needed. This position reports directly to the Quality Manager.

- Individuals will be expected to be in uniform utilizing proper PPE in an environment that can be very dangerous, loud and repetitive.
- Must have the ability to focus and be attentive to safety and effective performance.
- Must be able to read technical drawings.
- Must be able to bend, twist, stoop and lift and do repetitive motions.
- Must be able to do repetitive assembly tasks.
- Must be able to follow written and verbal instructions.
- Ability to perform visual and mag particle weld inspections.
- Must operate forklifts and overhead cranes.
- Ability to work with members of other departments regarding inspected products as well as communicate with vendors and purchasing regarding received products.
- Must be able to wear protective clothing, earplugs, safety glasses, etc. while performing many of the tasks.
